

Breaking news: Mr. X spotted in Aachen!

Mr. X is up to mischief in Aachen, go on a quest and follow his steps!

There are a total of three mysterious Mr. Xs in the city, located at the 60 spots marked on the map (on the back), and they move in regular intervals by foot along the lines drawn, exactly one mark further. They provide clues to their next locations on our website (<https://maphin.eu/mr-x>). You are free to move around and choose which Mr. X you want to chase. We recommend focusing on just one at a time. You can recognize Mr. X by a black coat, a black hat, an ESA shirt, and a hobby horse. If you find a Mr. X, you will receive a stamp and can then try to find one of the other Mr. Xs. But beware: Mr. X is quick and hides well. Combine all the clues to track his movements!

Further details and tips:

- Each of the 60 locations is surrounded by several features (restaurants, bakeries, pharmacies, etc.) on the map, with each feature belonging to exactly one location (the nearest one).
Each clue refers to one of the features of the location where Mr. X is (and he will also be standing right next to that feature, but always outside).
- Individual clues may always refer to many different locations. To find Mr. X, you have to combine several consecutive clues. For example, the fact that Mr. X is at an ice cream parlor doesn't mean much at first, but if he then moves to a neighboring location with a bakery, and from there to a parking lot (and so on), it gradually narrows down the number of possible routes.
- When Mr. X publishes a clue for the next location, he will only set off at that moment and will arrive there a few minutes later (so you have more time to get there too). So if you arrive very quickly at a location where you suspect Mr. X to be, don't be surprised if he isn't there yet.

Now get ready, prove your skills, and find Mr. X!
